<b>Fast-Facts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Working to address overcrowding and underfunding in Fredericksburg and Stafford schools</li> <li>• Fighting to lower healthcare costs, including out-of-pocket costs for Virginians with pre existing conditions.</li> <li>• Focused on criminal justice reform and working to end the school to prison pipeline.</li> </ul>
<b>Education</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Voted to make community college tuition free for low income students and create programs that will give VA students skills training in the fastest growing, high paying industries in the Commonwealth.</li> <li>• Voted to give VA teachers a pay raise and expanded access to broadband during the COVID 19 pandemic, so students could learn safely from home.</li> </ul>
<b>Health care</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Passed legislation that would lower out-of-pocket health care costs for Virginians with preexisting conditions.</li> <li>• Capped prescription drug costs for Virginians with chronic and pre existing conditions, like diabetes.</li> <li>• Endorsed by Planned Parenthood, and received an A rating from NARAL.</li> </ul>
<b>Criminal Justice Reform</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Supported Breona's Law, legislation that would end the use of no knock warrants</li> <li>• Voted to increase the minimum age for juveniles to be tried as adults in felony court and</li> </ul>
<b>Voting rights</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Carried legislation that would make it easier for people who are eligible to vote, including automatic voter registration.</li> <li>• Voted to expand voting rights</li> </ul>
<b>Renaming Jefferson Davis Hwy</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Carried legislation that would officially rename Jefferson Davis Highway to Emancipation Highway</li> </ul>
