### *Do I need an excuse to vote early by mail or early in person?*

No! Any registered voter may vote early without excuse. Visit [iwillvote.com/va](http://iwillvote.com/va) to apply for a vote by mail ballot or to find an early in person voting location.

### ***Do I need a photo ID to vote?***

You'll be asked to show ID, but you do not need a photo ID to vote. To cast a regular ballot, you must either: 1) provide an acceptable ID; or 2) sign an ID confirmation statement attesting to your identity. The list of acceptable IDs includes: 1) Federal, Virginia, or locally issued ID; 2) Student ID; 3) Employer ID; and 4) Current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document containing your name and address.

### ***How do I return my vote by mail ballot?***

Vote by mail ballots can be returned either by mail or by hand.

- *If by mail*, the ballots must be postmarked by November 2 for delivery to the General Registrar's office. Postage is prepaid on the return envelopes for ballots.
- *If by hand*, ballots can be hand delivered to in-person early voting locations, registrar offices, and Election Day polling precincts. Some localities also implement around-the-clock drop boxes during the early voting period.

### ***What if I requested a vote by mail ballot but now want to vote in person?***

No problem! If you bring your vote by mail ballot and ballot envelope to your in person voting location (either during the early vote period or on Election Day), you can trade them in for a regular ballot. If, during the early vote period, you have requested a ballot and have not received it or lost it, you can go in person to an early vote location, complete a gold form (*Statement of Voter AB Note Received or Lost*) and cast a regular ballot. If, on Election Day, you applied for and did not receive or lose your ballot and appear to vote in person, you will be required to vote a provisional ballot and sign the gold form.

### ***Do you need a witness signature on your vote by mail ballot envelope?***

Yes! Please remember to fill out the statement of voter on Envelope B - which includes printing your full name, writing down the Virginia address where you are registered, signing the envelope and obtaining a witness signature.
